GCSE English Language (8700) has a Spoken Language endorsement. This result will show as a Pass, Merit, Distinction or Not Classified (shown in **blue**).

GCSE Combined Science, awarded for this first time this year, will show two 9 to 1 grades (shown in **orange**).
