





FAQs

What types of training do you offer?

We provide both in-school and online training. Find out more about each type here:

In-school training Online training

We also offer some face-to-face training in the form of EPQ courses.

Who are your courses aimed at?

Our courses are aimed at a variety of different needs and levels – from teachers new to teaching, or to AQA, to experienced teachers who want to top up their teaching knowledge, acquire new skills or gain insights into a recent exam series.

What methods of delivery are used?

We use a range of methods, from Microsoft Teams, e-learning, face-to-face or INSET online (our online training platform). Our team thinks carefully about the outcomes needed and what will suit our customers best.

How long does each course last?

The length of our training courses depends on the programme and format. Feedback sessions are currently two hours long, but e-learning modules take different times to complete. Training is delivered by subject experts, and the delivery format is tailored to communicate the course subject in the most effective way. All our events are recorded for training and monitoring purposes.

In-school training lasts for a half (approx 2.5 hours), or full (approx 5 hours) day – depending on your needs. Training sessions are a re-run of our national courses, delivered for a group of teachers, leadership team or department. Our trainers come to you and will build in time to answer questions or discuss specific content with you. These courses can be done online or faceto-face.
