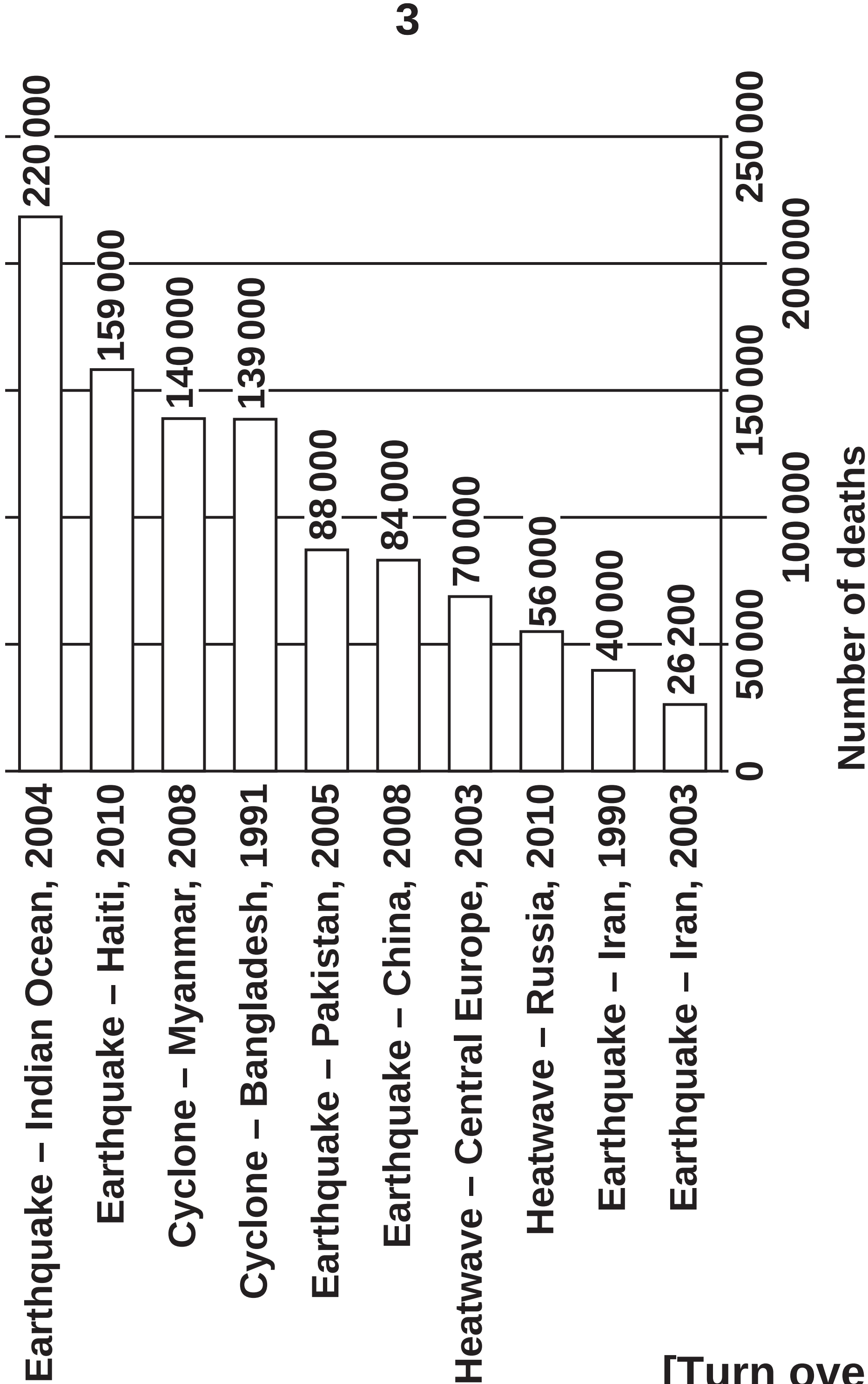
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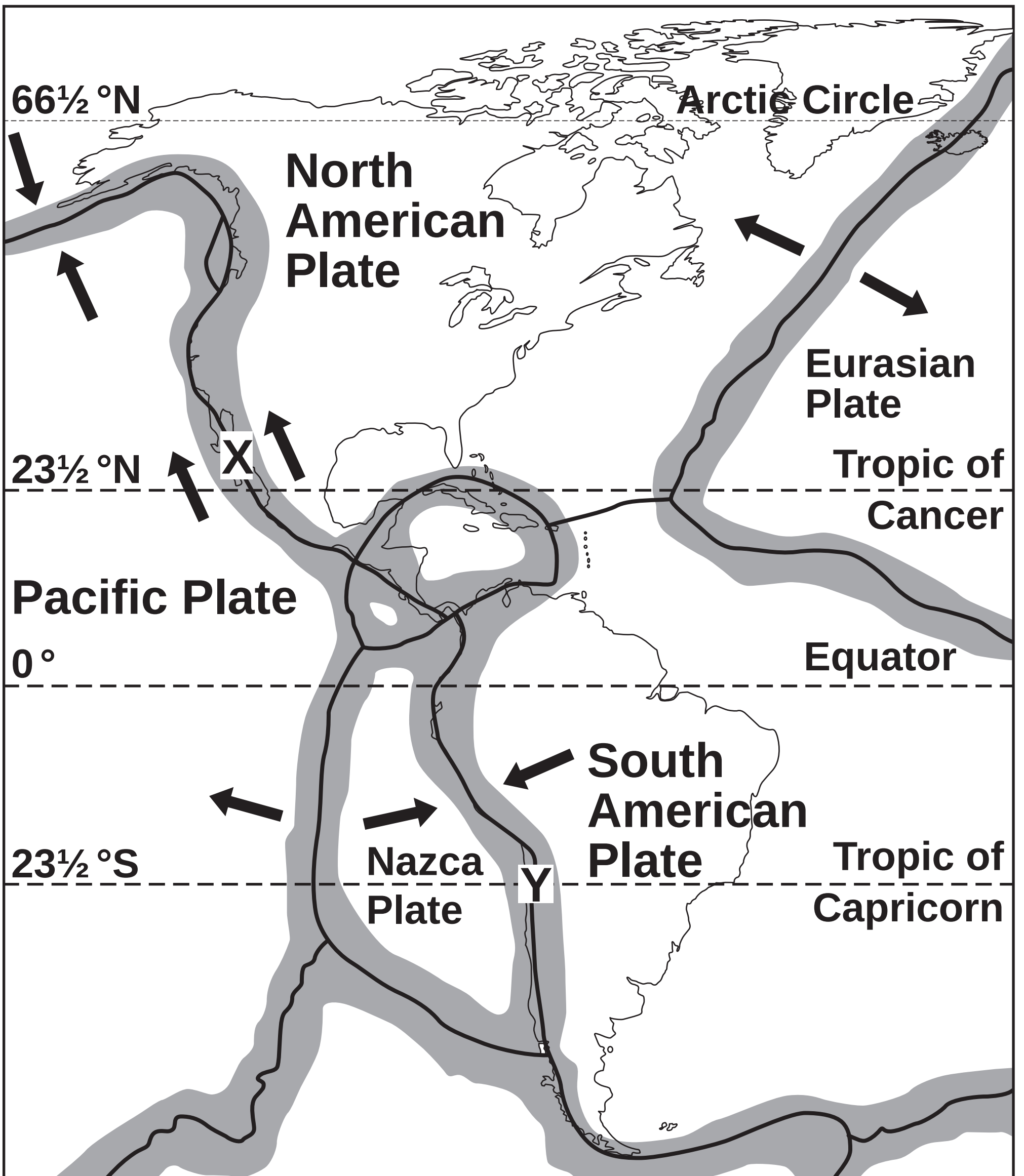

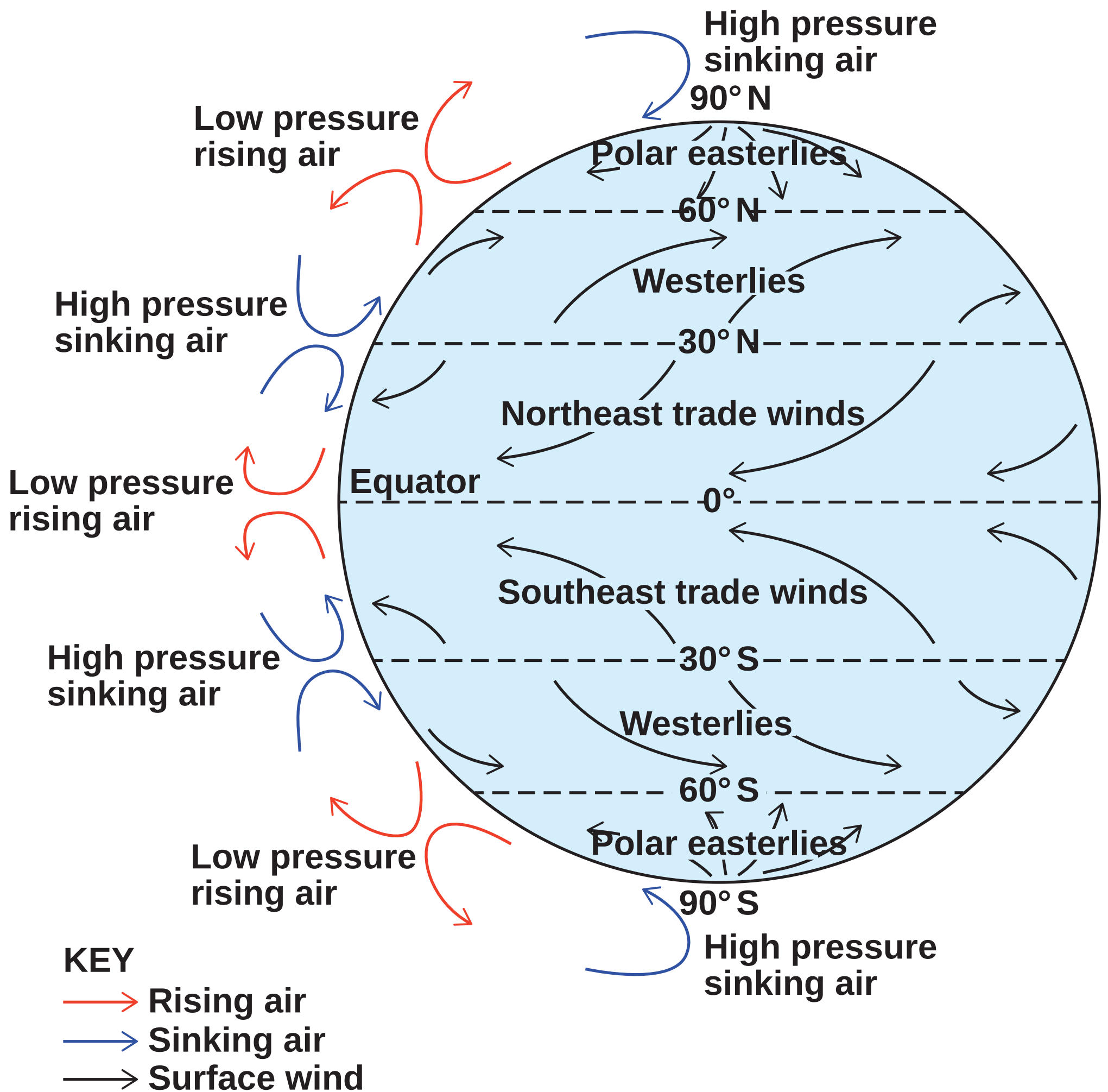


FIGURE 4 – For use with Question 1

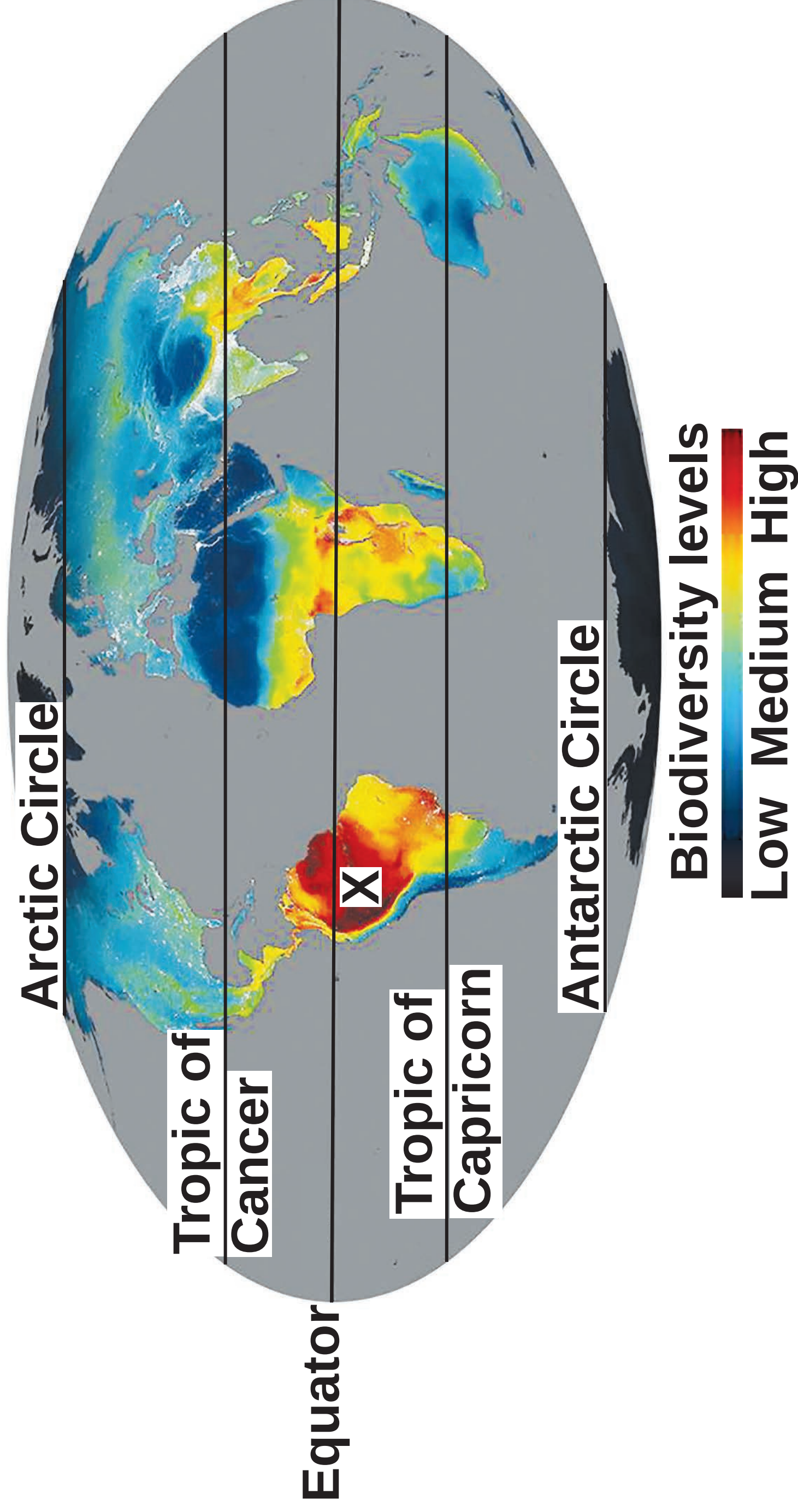
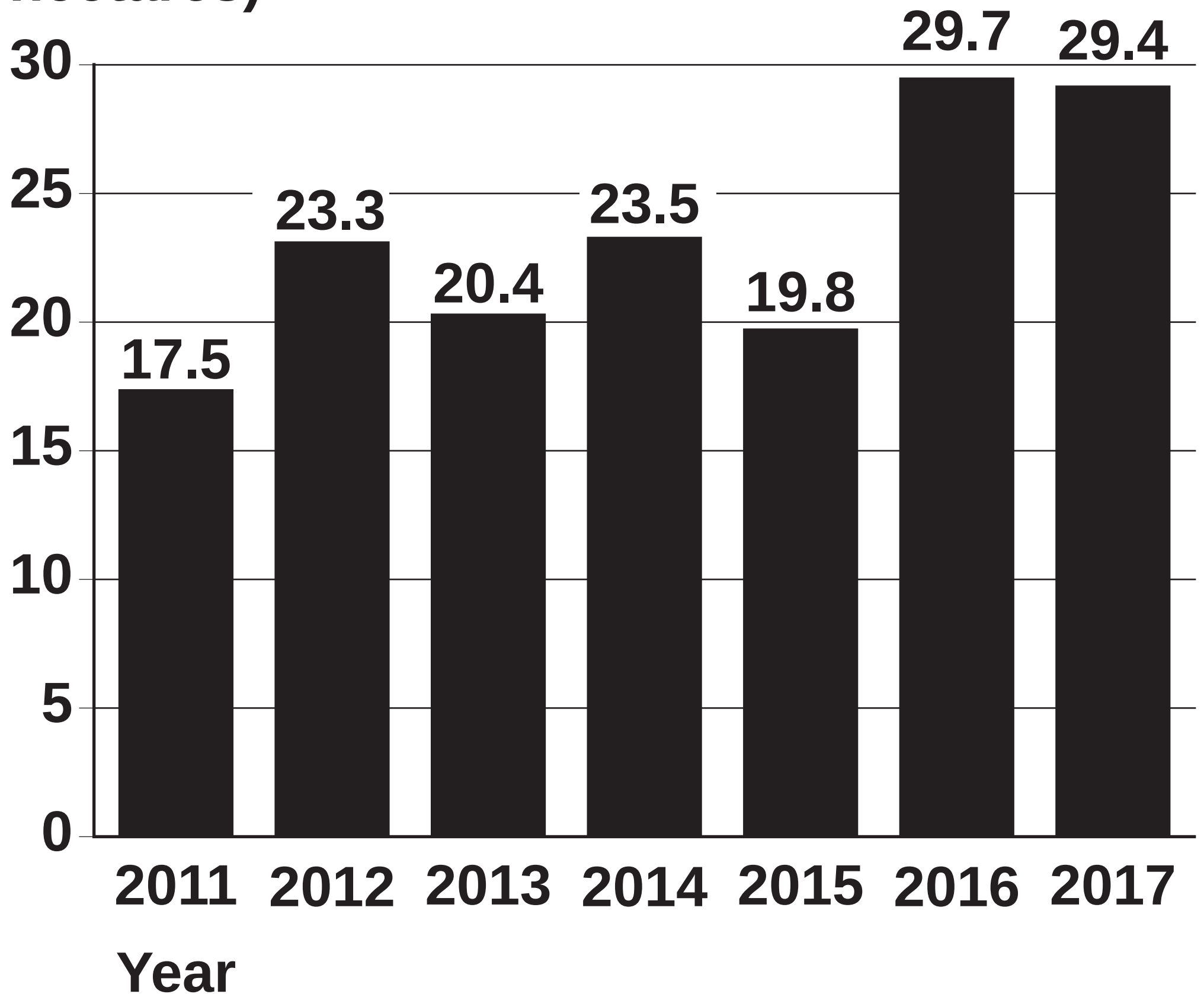


FIGURE 6 – For use with Question 2

Animal habitats are destroyed and many plant species are lost

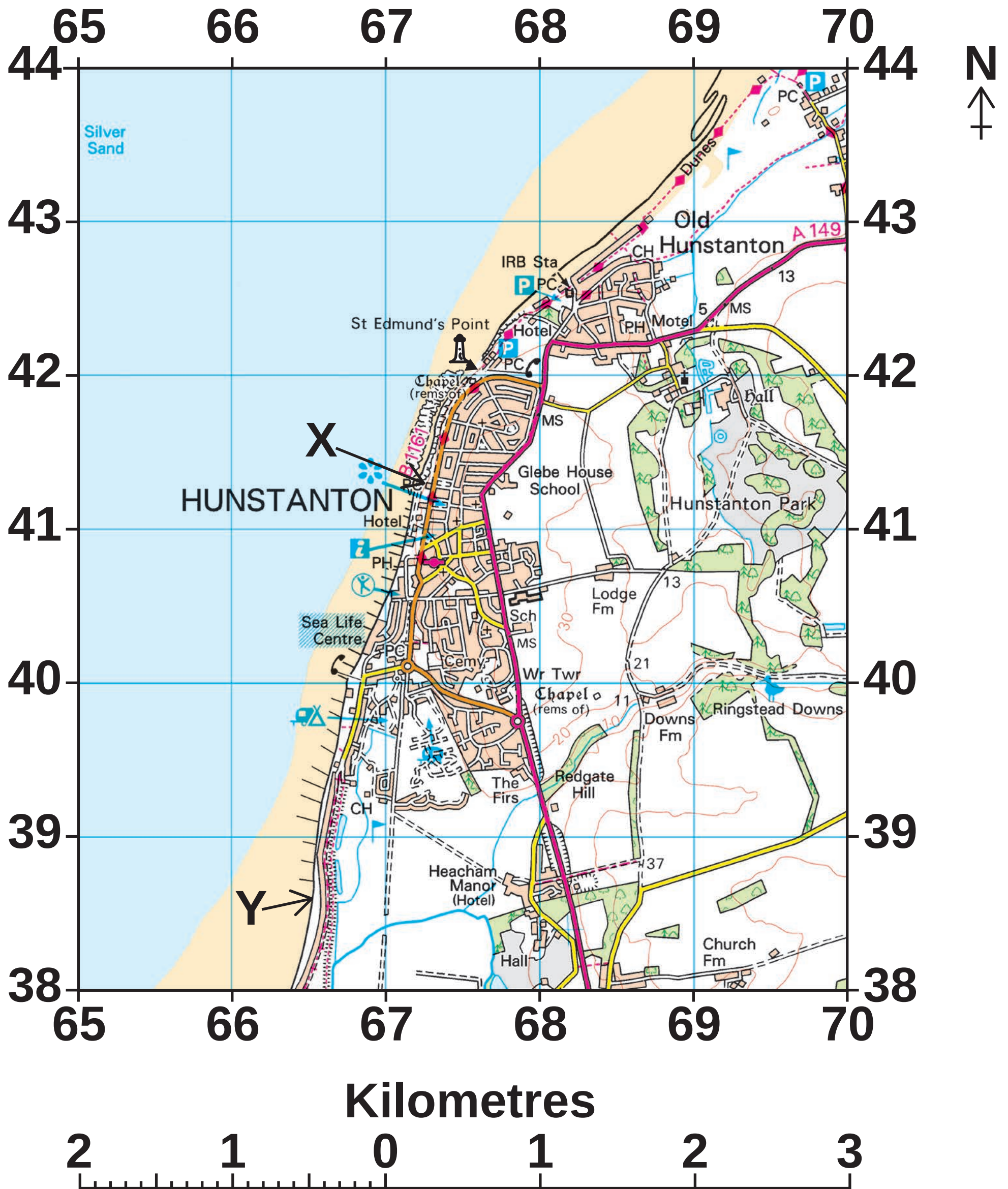
Many people have jobs in mining, logging and farming

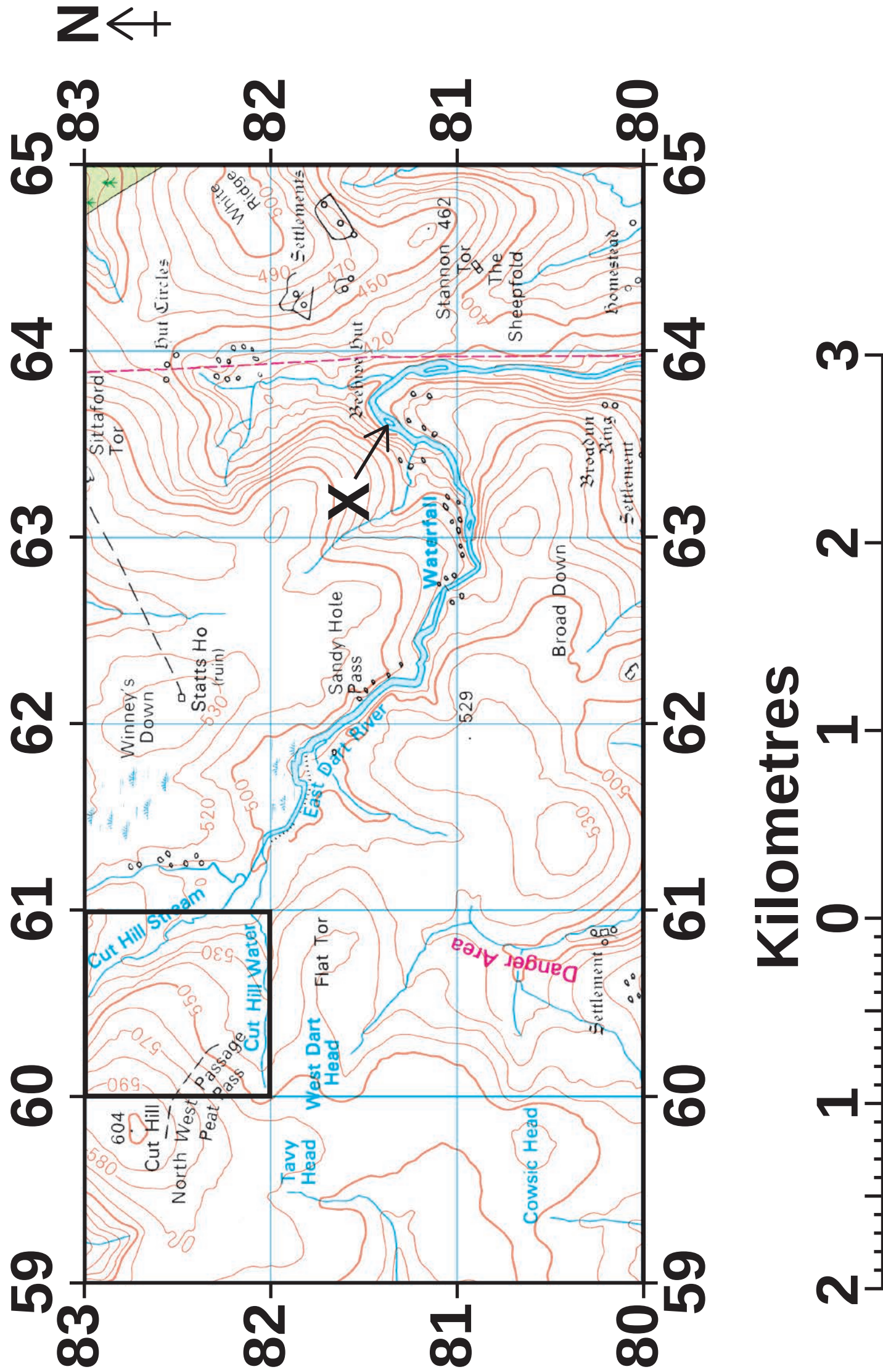


FIGURE 13 – For use with Question 4

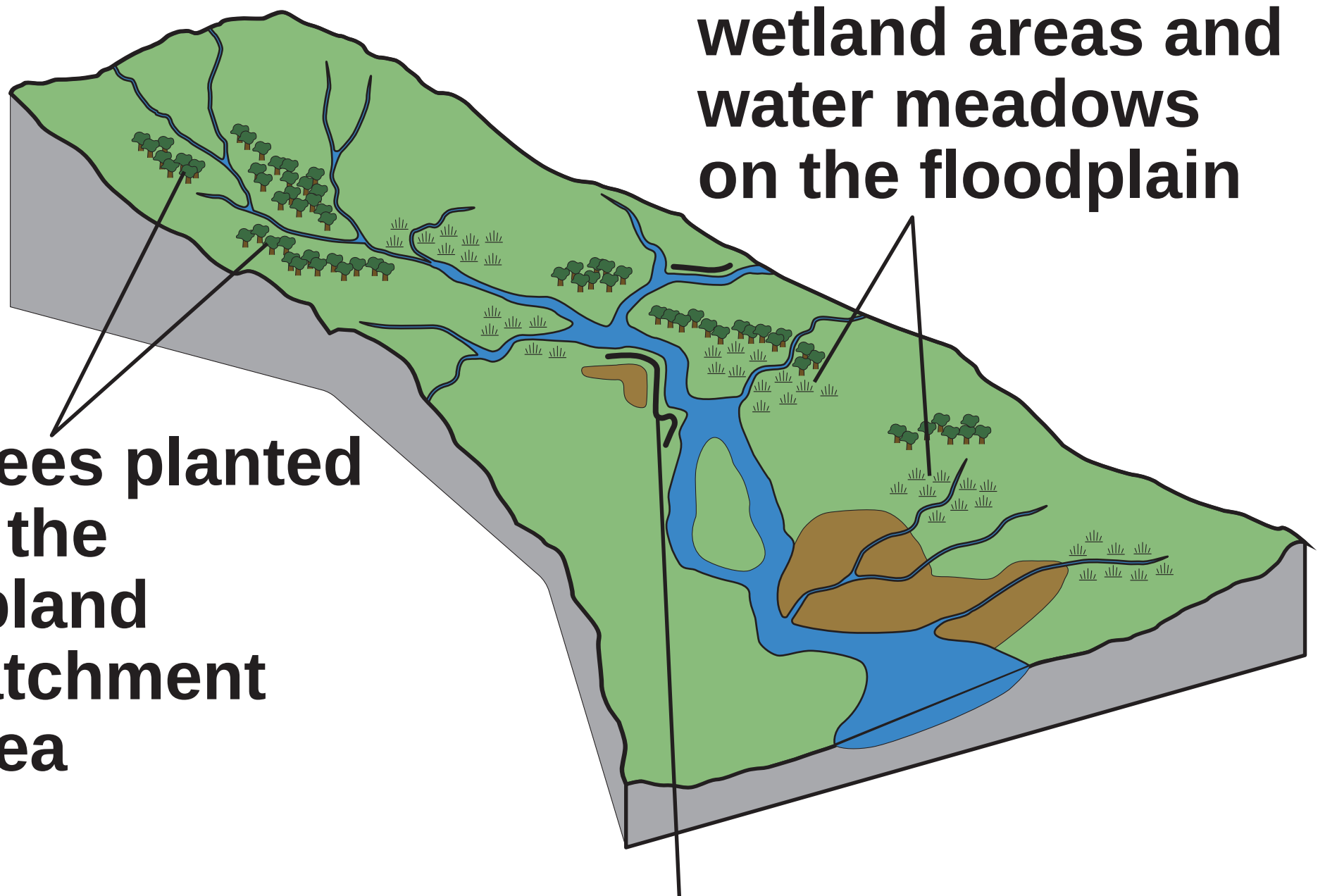
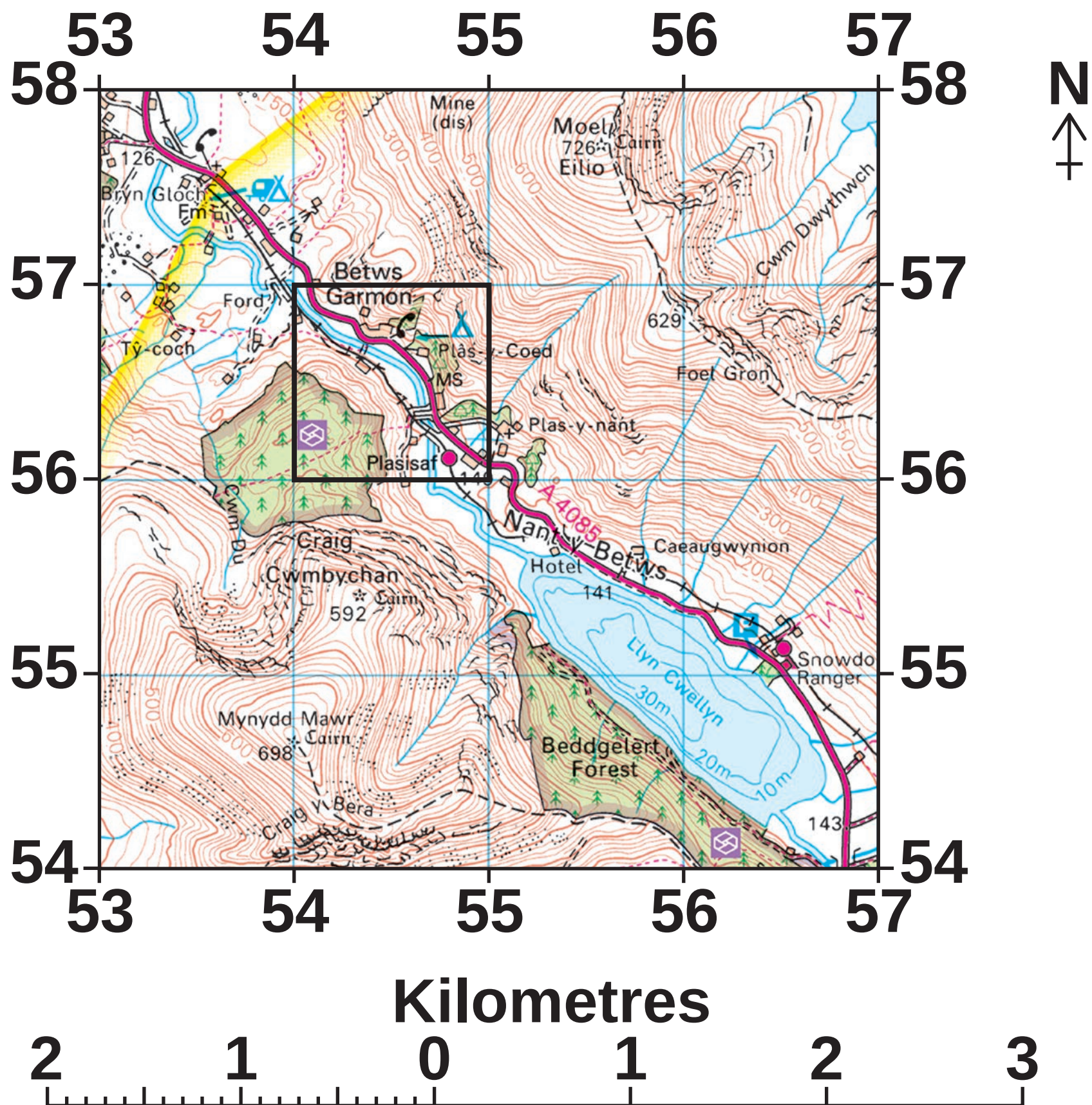


FIGURE 15 – For use with Question 5
