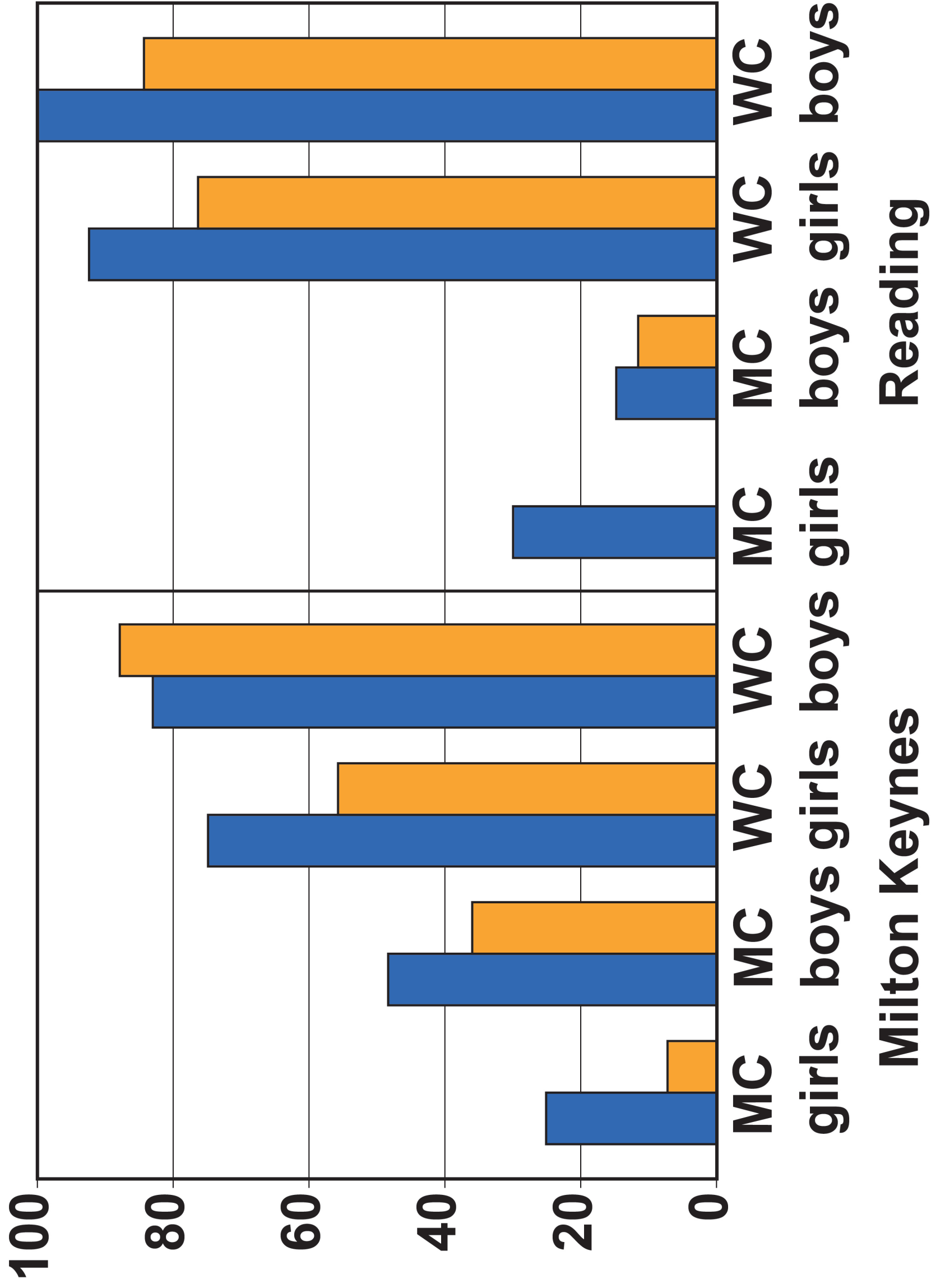
In your answer you should discuss concepts and issues from language study. You should use your own supporting examples and the data in FIGURE 1, on pages 12 and 13.
