## INTRODUCTION

Wherever possible we have included materials of varying complexity to meet the needs of different students. It is not envisaged that all of the material listed will be used. Teachers are advised to consult current publishers' lists and to inspect any book before ordering a class set or copy for the library / resources centre. Reviews, often by practising teachers, in the *Journal of Classics Teaching* published by JACT may also be a useful guide.
