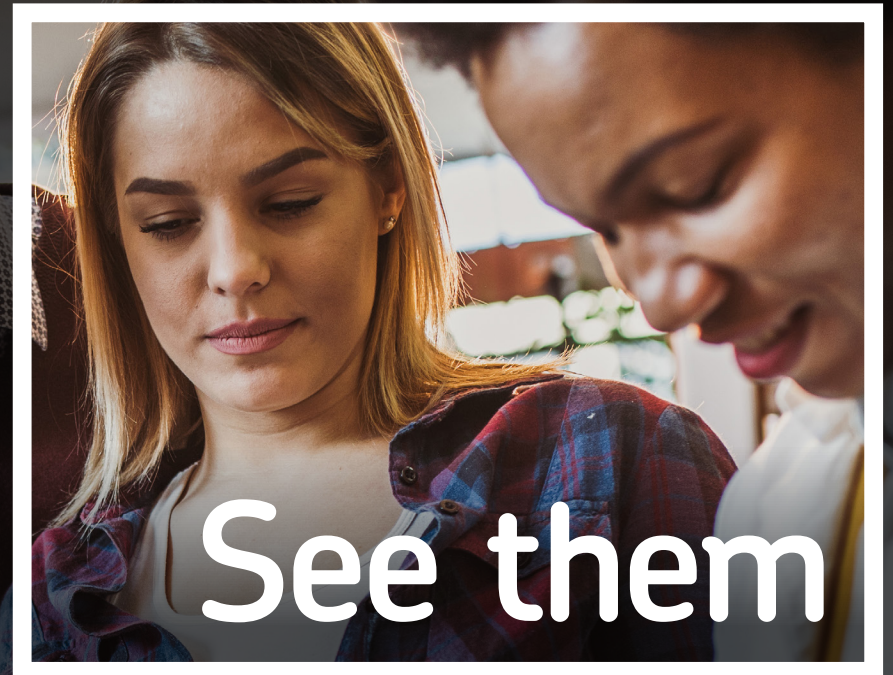


# Your student recruitment pack
